**EcoLogic Lofts**, 2359 N. Seeley: Plans were announced this week for roof-mounted turbines that will generate a portion of the energy for this 94-unit condo/loft development in Bucktown. The planned seven-story development will feature 1- and 2-bedroom lofts starting in the \$200,000 range.

Eight wind turbines are expected to provide approximately 2 percent of the building's power -- enough to maintain the development's common areas, said builder Bill Senne, CEO of Senco Properties. Senne has applied for a LEED certificate.
